CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

PHYSICAL EDUCATION & SPORTS DEPARTMENT

The Department of Physical Education has always been on its toes to bring laurels to the college. More than 20 teams of our college participate in intercollegiate tournaments in RTM Nagpur University. Players of various games are selected to represent the RTMNU team for University, State, National level tournaments. In addition to outdoor games, indoor Gymnasium facility is also available for college students. Medical Test and the Physical Efficiency Test is compulsory for the students of UG. The university credits maximum of 100 marks to the students after participation in sports at various level and their achievement levels.



NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC)

The NCC unit of the college is affiliated to 4 MAH BN Nagpur, with the permitted strength of 102 cadets, including 33% girl cadets. NCC provides exposure to the cadets in a wide range of activities, such as social services and adventure training. It provides a suitable environment to motivate the youth to take up a career in the Armed Forces. After completion of one year of training, cadets are eligible to get a maximum of 100 marks in CC course as per NEP 2020.



NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

Three Units containing 250 students are enrolled as NSS Volunteers. They perform regular activities related to social services like cleanliness, social and educational improvement. The NSS unit conducts a 7-day camp in the adopted villages. NSS unit organises Workshops, Seminars, Camps and Social Awareness Programmes etc. NSS Students are eligible to get a maximum of 100 marks under CC course as per NEP 2020 and also get opportunity to represent at state or national level.



CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

The Cultural Committee celebrates and observes the birth and death anniversaries of the national heroes. It promotes the students' participation in the cultural activities at various level like intra, inter, university, state and national etc. on the basis of level of participation student get maximum of 100 marks in CC course.



DEPARTMENT OF LIFELONG LEARNING & EXTENSION

Students are provided with opportunities to work in the department from the first year of UG and PG programmes. The department organises various activities, including Literacy Campaigns and other prescribed by RTMNU. programmes. Students actively participate in surveys related to various government schemes and also conduct surveys of senior citizens. The participating students get a maximum of 100 marks based on the performance of student in university prescribed project for CC course.
